Step 1: Open ball valve on pre-filter to dump any system pressure in unit.



Step 2: Disconnect pilot line from piston cover plate.



Step 3: Remove the four socket head cap screws holding the piston cover in place.



Step 4: Remove piston cover for access to piston.





Step 5: Using your finger or a ½-13 bolt, remove the piston from the bore; be sure you remove the piston spring.





Step 6: Remove o-ring from piston plug and replace with new o-ring; lightly grease.



Step 7: Lubricate the dryer bores prior to installing the new



Step 8: Install piston with spring. Attach piston cover plate and then connect pilot line.







Step 9: Close ball valve on pre-filter and slowly allow system pressure into unit.
